DAY 1

Transfer to your Hong Kong Hotel and spend the remainder of your day at leisure. Suggest you take in the City Sky line at one of the many rooftop bars Hong Kong has to offer. Maybe the Ozone, located at the Ritz Carlton. This is the highest rooftop bar in the world.

DAY 2

This morning you will commence your Hong Kong Island Tour. This 5 hour tour departs at 8.00am and is an excellent orientation to begin your stay in Hong Kong. On this tour you will visit the famous fishing village of Aberdeen. A stop at Stanley Markets where you can pick up some bargains for a fraction of the price in town. Travel to Victoria Peak for a panoramic view of Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the surrounding Islands. Enjoy the famous peak tram ride on the way back down. Before returning to your Hotel you will pass by picturesque Repulse Bay. This evening you will enjoy a cultural and culinary experience by joining the 4 hour Kowloon Street Eats Tour which departs at 6.00pm. Visit five hand picked locations and eat as the locals do on the steets and in the Dai Pai Dongs. This will also give you an opportunity to explore the local sights of Jordan and Yau Ma Tei at night.

DAY 3

A cultural day at leisure. My suggestion would be to take a stroll through Kowloon Park in the morning, and then maybe catch the MTR to the Jade Market to shop for jade and jewelry. Take a walk around the streets to see how the locals live. Perhaps try the local yum cha. The ladies markets in Mongkok are open from midday to midnight. A great way to finish off your day would be a visit to a Chinese reflexologist for a relaxing foot massage.

DAY 4

Morning at leisure. This afternoon join the Come Horse Racing Tour in Sha Tin, where you will have the luxury of being in the visitors box in the members area. Buffet lunch and beverages are included along with a welcome pack, including HKD30 betting voucher.

Day 5

For a multicultural day out, visit the outlying Islands by taking the ferry across to Lamma Island. The ferry will drop you off at Yung Shue Wan. The walking path is a leisurely hour stroll to the other side of the Island where you will pass by the community where the expats and locals live, the lush greenery, local pubs and quirky shops. Once you get to the other side of the Island enjoy a fresh seafood lunch at one of the many seafood restaurants which are located only a few minutes walk from Sok Kwu Wan ferry terminal, where you will be catching the ferry back to Hong Kong. This evening you may want to treat yourself and dine out at one of the many Michelin Star Restaurants.

DAY 6

Shop till you drop! Start your shopping day in Kowloon. The Harbour City complex has over 500 International brand shops. If you choose to take a 2 hour break from your shopping you may want to catch the MTR from Kowloon to Tung Chung Station near Lantau Island, where you can take the Cable Car up to view the Big Buddha. While you are here, you can enjoy a vegetarian lunch cooked by the Monks at the Monastery. After lunch catch the Cable Car and MTR back to Tung Chung Station where you can continue your shopping. It is a short 5 minute walk from the Station to the Citygate Factory Outlets which are open until 9.00pm.

DAY 7

Morning at leisure. Maybe enjoy a high tea at the Peninsula Hotel. This evening you could view the spectacular light show on Victoria Harbour by doing the Symphony of Lights Harbour Cruise, or perhaps on the beautifully restored Aqua Luna Chinese junk boat. Following your cruise, you may want to catch the MTR over to Central on Hong Kong Island where you can dance the night away in the trendy night life district of Lan Kwai Fong. Famous for its many bars, wine bars, quaint restaurants and funky night clubs.

DAY 8

Today stroll around Central on Hong Kong Island. Walk through Hollywood Road, Antique Street and Cat Street visit the art galleries and antique stores. Finish off with lunch in the lively dining district of Soho, famous for its funky bars and chic restaurants offering a huge range of international cuisine. Departure transfer from your Hotel to the Airport.
