



TAHITI

DAY 1:

On arrival be transferred to your hotel. When you arrive at the Papeete Faa'a International Airport, you will retrieve your luggage and go through Customs. When exiting the Customs area, directly to the right you will find the Marama Tours greeting board which will have your name on it. Marama Tours will greet you, adorn you with a fresh flower lei and provide you with a shared seat-in-coach transfer to your hotel, the InterContinental Tahiti Resort & Spa for a 2 night stay.

DAY 2:

Morning ½ day Circle Island Tour

Today board your air-conditioned coach and circle the main island of Tahiti with an experienced English speaking guide. You will be introduced to some of Tahiti's charming facets of both yesterday and today, with many historical notes and amusing anecdotes. Tour highlights include "One Tree Hill" panoramic lookout point, Point Venus historical landing site of the original explorers and lighthouse, the Arahoho Blowhole, and Faaraumi Waterfalls. In the afternoon, visit the Robert Wan Pearl Museum. Take a ride on Le Truck, Papeete's public transport, and enjoy a meal at Les Roulottes on the Esplanade.

DAY 4:

Check out of the Intercontinental Tahiti Resort You will be transferred from your hotel to the Papeete pier. Board the "Terevau" Ferry Service from Papeete to Moorea at 11:30am. Upon arrival to the Moorea Ferry Dock, you will find a representative of Albert Transport who will direct you to the transfer vehicle, assist you in loading your luggage onto the vehicle and transfer you to your hotel, the InterContinental Moorea Resort & Spa

DAY 5:

4WD Safari Excursion

Discover the beautiful volcanic island of Moorea, its tropical flora and aquatic fauna on a 4x4 tour. Your guide takes you to the pineapple fields, bamboo groves and orange, grapefruit, papaya and vanilla plantations. Enjoy the breath-taking view from the Belvedere high lookout point and pay a visit to the archaeological sites and temples of pre-contact Polynesia. Stories and legends of ancient "Eimeo" (one of Moorea's original names) will be narrated to you on the way. Ascend "Magic Mountain" – an optional hike that travels the last 90 meters to the summit for a stunning view of Moorea's north shore. Our stop at the fruit juice plant and distillery is the opportunity to sample our local liqueurs and fruit juices. Also a short stop at one of the local pearl stores is included. Don't forget your camera! Insect repellent is also recommended.

DAY 6:

Day at leisure. During the day, you may wish to book a swim with the dolphins at your hotel.

DAY 7:

Check out of the Intercontinental Moorea Resort You will be transferred from the InterContinental Moorea Resort to the Moorea Airport by coach.

Make sure you sit on the left hand side of the aircraft to have great views of Bora Bora as you approach landing Bora Bora airport is located on a remote island, hence you need to be transferred by boat to the hotel. Upon arrival to the Bora Bora Airport, you will find a representative of the Intercontinental Thalasso Resort who will direct you to the transfer boat and give you baggage tags to attach to your luggage.

Check into the perfectly located, this Bora Bora Resort & Thalasso Spa which is set between the two hearts of Motu Piti Aau, a coral island on the barrier reef. They will show you the best way to see and touch the animals that you've seen and heard so much about. Picnic lunch on the motu is included.

DAY 9:

Day at leisure. Between the turquoise waters of the lagoon and the deep blue of the ocean, Deep Ocean Spa offers areas for hydrotherapy, beauty care and gentle energy. There are also glass-floored overwater bungalows enabling you to admire the marine life during the sessions you choose, whether you are alone or a couple. Check out of the Intercontinental Thalasso Resort. You will be transferred from the InterContinental Thalasso Resort to the Bora Bora Airport by boat
