#### Day 1: Wednesday 2nd March 2022

Hobart

Meals: None

Welcome to Tasmania! A group airport transfer is included, if you are travelling outside of the group please make your own way to the start hotel. On arrival make a trip to the summit of Kunyanyi (Mount Wellington) for spectacular, sprawling views of the city and southern Tasmania. Then travel on to the quirky Museum of Old and New Art, home to an eclectic collection of pieces.

Day 2: Thursday 3rd March 2022

Strahan

Meals: Breakfast

We leave Hobart and drive through the Derwent Valley – travelling east to west across the island. You will see the beautiful Russell Falls, walk among the Mt Field National Park Tall Trees, and visit Australia's deepest freshwater lake, Lake St Clair. Explore the pristine Franklin-Gordon Wild River National Park and end the day in Strahan. Accommodation: Strahan Village

Today we experience a full day steam train journey, you will travel the length of the West Coast Wilderness Railway in both directions, stopping at every station along the line and hearing the many stories of the resilient people and extraordinary events that brought the railway to life.

Day 4: Saturday 5th March 2022

Cradle Mountain

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

A wonderful cruise on the Gordon River, one of the most beautiful rivers in Australia. We venture deep into the UNESCO Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area to share with you, the ancient rainforest, mysterious history, and colourful characters of Tasmania's west coast. Enjoy lunch on board before alighting to walk through the forest. A short drive takes us to Cradle Mountain. Included

#### Day 5: Sunday 6th March 2022

Stanley

Meals: Breakfast

This morning we will spend time in the stunning Cradle Mountain National Park. With many options to enjoy the breath-taking peaks, you can take a walk around the lovely Dove Lake in Cradle Valley or hike up to Marion's Lookout for breathtaking views across the area - the options are open for you. Next, we visit the historic Table Cape Lighthouse, perched atop the rocky cliff's edge. In Stanley, climb the famous landmark The Nut, an ancient volcanic plug that juts out into the Bass Strait and offers outstanding views from the top.

#### Day 6: Monday 7th March 2022

Launceston Meals: Breakfast

We journey today along the Northwest coast to Launceston, with plenty of stops along the way. Enjoy a whisky tasting tour at Hellyer's Road Distillery, and further along the Tasting Trail you will have the option to sample local beers at Buttons Brewing. Then one of Tasmania's outdoor art galleries, the Sheffield Murals. If you have a sweet tooth, Anvers Chocolate may be calling you to taste its famous truffles! There will be more optional stops for tastings if time permits, including for locally grown raspberries, cheese, and ice cream.

#### Day 9: Thursday 10th March 2022

An early start means we are the first to the Wineglass Bay lookout, beating the crowds and the heat for that postcard photo. Relax on the secluded beach or choose the more challenging Mt Amos or a beach walk. We continue our journey south passing the coastal villages of Swansea and Orford before arriving back to Hobart.

Hop on the ferry over to Bruny Island. Explore South Bruny National Park, where the Cape Bruny Lighthouse perched high above the wild waves of the Southern Ocean. Visit Cloudy Bay, at the southernmost tip of the island, where whaling stations operated in the mid-1800s. See the beautiful coastline of Adventure Bay and stop in at a few local Bruny Island shops for tastings of locally sourced products such as cheese, oysters, honey.

Today, the Salamanca Markets await, ready to tempt you with local delights – everything from fresh produce to handmade crafts. We will spend 2 hours exploring the market, then head to the historic town of Richmond. From there, head down the peninsula to the southern tip at Port Arthur. Driving down the beautiful Forestier and Tasman peninsulas, we will pass through the narrow sliver of land that is Eaglehawk Neck and stop at Tasman Arch and Devil's Kitchen, where the surging sea meets stunning rock formations. Once we reach Port Arthur, you can explore the Historic Site, a former convict settlement with a horrific past. Included

Feast on local delights at the Hobart farmers' market, where you can meet local producers and browse for seasonal Tassie produce like gooseberries, pine mushrooms or fresh oysters, depending on the time of year. Depart for the Huon Valley and the riverside town of Franklin where we will visit the Wooden Boat Centre, to learn the fine art of hand-crafted timber boats. From here we will go to Geeveston, a small township known for its forestry heritage and gateway to the Hartz Mountains National Park. Our last stop in the Huon Valley is to learn about the history of local apple farming, maybe with a few cider samples, at a fourth-generation orchard and cidery.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS COVID BORDER CLOSURES TRAVEL INSURANCE

These tour arrangements have been organised through INTREPID TRAVEL using local accommodation and tour operators. All bookings are made with your local Intrepid entity as set out in clause 26, acting as agent for Intrepid Travel Pty Ltd (ABN 35 007 172 456) (us/we). By booking a trip with us you have agreed to be bound by the terms and conditions set out in :<a href="https://www.intrepidtravel.com/au/booking-intrepid/booking-conditions">https://www.intrepidtravel.com/au/booking-intrepid/booking-conditions</a> and Temora Travel's terms and conditions (which constitutes the agreement between you and us). Your booking will be accepted by us on this basis.

#### Acceptance of booking and final payments

If we accept your booking, we will issue you with a booking confirmation invoice. A contract will exist between you and us from the date we issue the confirmation invoice or if you book within 21 days of departure the contract will exist when we accept your payment. Please refer to your booking confirmation invoice for details regarding final payments, including how to make the payment. Payment of the balance of the trip price is due 21 days before the departure date. If this balance is not paid on or before the due date we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled and any cancellation charges outlined at clause 7 (Cancellation by You) will apply.

#### Cancellation by you

A cancellation will only be effective when we receive written confirmation of the cancellation. If you cancel your trip:

- 21 days or more prior to departure, we will hold your deposit as a credit and retain \$200pp; or
- 20 days or fewer prior to departure:
  - we will hold 50% of the monies paid by you in connection with the booking as a credit and retain the remaining 50% of monies paid by you in connection with your booking; or
  - o and the cancellation is due to you having COVID-19/ "flu-like symptoms", supported by a medical certificate, we will hold 100% of monies paid by you in connection with the booking as credit.

Any credit resulting from a cancellation under this clause 7 (Cancellation by you) does not have an expiry date and may be applied towards any other available trip offered by us. This credit is not transferable or redeemable for cash. This credit excludes flights or insurance as they will have their own booking conditions. You are strongly advised to take out cancellation insurance at the time of booking. If you leave a trip for any reason after it has commenced, we are not obliged to make any refunds for unused services. If you fail to join a trip, join it after departure, or leave it prior to its completion, no refund will be made.

#### Cancellation by us

In the event that we cancel your trip, you can transfer amounts paid to an alternate departure date or receive a refund, unless your trip is cancelled due to a Force Majeure Event (as defined below in this clause 8.

#### Cancellation due to Force Majeure

If a trip is cancelled due to a Force Majeure Event, we can offer you a choice of:

- (a) a 110% credit of \$4,240 paid for your trip to Intrepid Travel and 100% credit of \$855 Temora Travel fee; or
- (b) a refund minus unrecoverable costs which includes the \$855 Temora Travel fee

If the cancellation due to a Force Majeure Event occurs after a trip has commenced, we can offer you a choice of a pro-rata:

- (a) 110% credit for the days that remain on your trip; or
- (b) refund minus unrecoverable costs of the days that remain on your trip.

Any credit resulting from a cancellation under this clause 8 (Cancellation by us):

- does not have an expiry date and may be applied towards any other available trip offered by us;
- is not redeemable for cash;
- excludes flights or insurance as they will have their own booking conditions.

TRAVEL INSURANCE is strongly recommended for all domestic travel within Australia. Cover for some coronavirus related events is available on our Australian Plan. This includes: - Unlimited expenses if the traveller contracts coronavirus during the trip. - Medical evacuation and repatriation so you can return home safely. - Non-refundable travel costs when the trip gets cancelled because someone in the travelling party gets diagnosed with coronavirus. - Non-refundable travel costs when a close relative gets coronavirus and is hospitalised. - Non-refundable travel costs when you are a healthcare worker, residential care worker or law enforcement officer and your leave gets cancelled due to coronavirus. - When accommodation is cleaned for closing following a confirmed case of coronavirus and you need to stay at alternative accommodation. - Additional travel costs if a traveller is denied boarding transport because they are suspected of having coronavirus. - Additional compulsory quarantine costs such as hotel, meals, and in-room entertainment if you get sick with coronavirus or are considered a 'close contact' during the trip.
