Day 1 - 31 July 2020: Arrive Cairns, Port Douglas

Travel by coach from Phillip Island to the airport for your afternoon flight to Cairns. On arrival transfer to your resort in Port Douglas.

Two Nights: Port Douglas, Sheraton Grand Mirage Resort.

Day 02- 1 August 2020 Port Douglas

Enjoy a day of leisure, you might like to go for a dip in one of the resorts many pools, or head into Port Douglas for a wander through town. Tonight enjoy a relaxed Welcome Dinner with your fellow travellers. **BD**

Day 03 – 2 August 2020: Mossman Gorge, Daintree National Park

Travel to Mossman Gorge in Daintree National Park and set off on the Ngadiku Dreamtime Gorge Walk, led by local Indigenous guides. Starting with a smoking ceremony, journey along private, gentle tracks, visiting culturally significant sites and traditional bark shelters, meandering past cool rainforest streams. Learn about traditional hunting and gathering techniques and hear stories of the Dreamtime. Later, embark on a Daintree River Cruise and keep an eye out for crocodiles, butterflies and a variety of reptile species. Tonight, dine amidst the rainforest in an open-air restaurant. **BLD**

Stay: Daintree National Park, Heritage Lodge.

Day 04 – 3 August 2020: Cape Tribulation, Bloomfield Track, Cooktown

Explore Cape Tribulation this morning, the only place in Australia where two World Heritage-listed phenomenons meet – the Daintree Rainforest and the Great Barrier Reef. Later, set off along the Bloomfield Track, one of Australia's most iconic outback roads. Afterwards, arrive in Cooktown and discover the Cooktown Botanic Gardens and the James Cook Museum. Just before sunset, savour views from Grassy Hill Lookout over the Endeavour River. **BLD**

Stay: Cooktown, Sovereign Resort Hotel.

Day 05 – 4 August 2020: Quinkan Country, Laura, Rinyirru (Lakefield) National Park

Travel to Quinkan Country, ranked as one of the top 10 rock art areas in the world by UNESCO. Here, embark on a walk with an Indigenous guide to Split Rock, an intriguing rock art site where Quinkan figures depicting native animals, spirits and totems have been painted onto the rock face. Afterwards, to the Old Laura Homestead. Later, turn off into Rinyirru (Lakefield) National Park, home to crocodiles, wallabies and an array of bird life. Afterwards, arrive at Lotus Bird Lodge and retreat to your log-style cabin before a nature walk around the property's serene billabong. **BLD**

Stay: Lotus Bird Lodge.

Day 06 – 5 August 2020: Musgrave, Coen, Gulf Country, Weipa

Journey to Musgrave, the only remaining overland telegraph station on the peninsula. Explore the old gold mining town of Coen and stop at the well-known Archer River Roadhouse for lunch. Afterwards, continue to the town of Weipa, home to the largest community on the Cape York Peninsula. Here, set out on a sunset boat trip and relax as you learn about the region's unique ecosystem, mining industry and Indigenous culture. Enjoy nibbles and drinks on board as you keep your eyes peeled for crocs lazing on the banks. **BLD**

Stay: Weipa, Albatross Bay Resort.

Day 07 – 6 August 2020: Steve Irwin Wildlife Reserve, Bramwell Station

Today is sure to be one of the highlights of your journey as you enjoy a visit to the Steve Irwin Wildlife Reserve, which is normally off-limits to the general public. Board a helicopter in Weipa and fly into the reserve, gaining an aerial perspective on this vast wilderness area. On arrival, you'll be welcomed by a ranger from Australia Zoo, who will provide an introduction to the wildlife and sonar detector tracking methods. After lunch at Camp Coolibah, discover the movement of crocodiles in the area and the endangered Speartooth Shark. You will also see a demonstration on how crocodile cages are deployed and operated.

Learn about bush tucker and the native flora, including the Sarsaparilla Bush and Hanguana Malayana. **BLD**

Stay: Bramwell Station.

Day 08 – 7 August 2020: Fruit Bat Falls, Punsand Bay

Observe the towering termite mounds of Bramwell Junction before continuing on with your adventure. Stop at Fruit Bat Falls and cool off with a refreshing swim in the pristine waters of the Elliott River. Cross Jardine River by ferry, then skirt Jardine River National Park and continue through the traditional land of the Injinoo Indigenous people. **BLD**

Two Nights: Punsand Bay.

Day 09 – 8 August 2020: Punsand Bay, Tip of Cape York

Awake this morning to sweeping views of the tip of Cape York and travel along a 4WD track to Frangipani Beach. From here, take a walk to the tip of the peninsula to experience being at the Australian mainland's most northerly point. Take in the stunning vistas over the Torres Strait, then afterwards, take to the skies as you embark on a scenic helicopter flight over the tip of Cape York. Later, travel to historic Somerset Hill, the site of a station established by John Jardine in 1863. **BLD**

Day 10 - 9 August 2020: Thursday Island

Ferry across Endeavour Strait to Thursday Island, which was once a base for pearling luggers. Step back in time with a visit to Green Hill Fort, located atop the island's highest hill. Admire views of the mangrove-covered coastlines, azure waters and golden-sand beaches. You'll also enjoy time at the Gab Titui Cultural Centre. **BLD**

Stay: Thursday Island, Grand Hotel.

Day 11 - 10 August 2020: Horn Island, Fly to Cairns

Transfer to Horn Island aboard the local ferry. On a guided tour, visit the World War II Base and Torres Strait Heritage Museum. Later, board an included Qantas flight from Horn Island over the Great Barrier Reef and marvel at this spectacle from the air before arriving in Cairns. Tonight, enjoy a dinner at the hotel. **BLD**

Stay: Cairns, Shangri-La Hotel, The Marina.

Day 12 - 11 August 2020: Cairns

Enjoy a day of leisure before meeting up for your Farewell Dinner this evening. **BD**

Day 13 - 12 August 2020: Depart Cairns

Transfer to the airport for your morning flight. On arrival into Melbourne, travel by coach to Phillip Island.
