Day 1 - Saturday 30 October 2021

Arrive Sydney

Day 2 - Sunday 31 October

The tour provides an optional snorkelling experience at Erscott's Hole or you can just relax on the boat and view the stunning diversity of this exotic marine location. (2 hours duration). After an afternoon at leisure, immerse yourself in the world of lan Hutton, Australian botanist and resident, as lan introduces you to the island that is Lord Howe. Following lan's talk dinner will be held at Coral Cafe

Day 4 - Tuesday 2 November

Island Bus Toui

Today enjoy a refreshing introduction on what to do on Lord Howe, where to go and how to do it. Learn everything about the island there is to know. After a half day at leisure enjoy dinner at the Golf Course BD

Day 5 - Wednesday 3 November

Around Island Cruise & Historical Movies

Relax and enjoy our 2 hour cruise as you take in the breath-taking views all around Lord Howe Island including the spectacular image of Balls Pyramid creeping up in the distance and sheer Mountain cliffs. During the cruise you will approach the 'Admiralty Islands' which are home to a large percentage of the Island's bird population. At 5pm revel in historical movies at the Local Hall, before dinner at the Anchorage Restaurant BD

Day 6 - Thursday 4 November

North Bay Turtle & Nature Tour

View the large variety fish, turtles, stingrays and amazing corals of the world's southern most barrier reef on our glass bottom boat, 'Adventure One'. While exploring North Bay you can climb up Mt. Eliza, walk to the Old Gulch or Herring Pools, view the sea bird rookery (seasonal) or enjoy a swim. Amazing snorkel opportunity is provided through our optional snorkel of the wreck of the 'Favourite' which ran aground in 1965. (3 & ½ hours duration). Tonight dinner will be served at the Bowling Club BD

Day 7 - Friday 5 November

Walk to Little Island

Following the morning at leisure savour lunch at the Golf Course, before embarking on a walk of Little Island. View the spectacular aerial courtship displays by the winter breeding providence petrel. One of the world's rarest birds, the providence petrel returns to the island to nest and can be 'called' out of the air, landing at your feet and even climbing into your lap! Dinner at the Anchorage Restaurant BLD

Day 8 - Saturday 6 November

Depart Lord Howe Island

Transfer to the airport for your morning flight. On arrival into Melbourne, travel by coach to Phillip Island

Group Bookings
